Il good things come to those who wait', so the saying goes. But, for Christine Walker, 30 years was about the limit.

"I'd always promised myself a new kitchen since we moved into the house in the '70s, but somehow we've never got around to it," she says, having 'made do' with some ex-display units installed originally as a temporary solution.


"Finally, we earmarked some money and decided to get going," explains Christine, who, with husband, Mark, agreed that their Georgian farmhouse in the Worcestershire countryside deserved something better than the worn cupboards and wobbly table that were serving as their kitchen. But, with 40 acres to farm, a flock of ewes about to lamb and a horse with foal to care for, not to mention a mapping and geological business

to run, it's hardly surprising that there wasn't much time to visit a string of showrooms for ideas.

"Fortunately, my farrier recommended Warwick Lifestyle. Not only did we like the designs, but we were attracted by the fact that they would project manage the whole job, down to the electrics and painting," explains Christine, adding that the room had to be gutted and old broken floor tiles removed before the new work could be carried out.

Design Directors, Carlos Park and Stephen Tombs, took on board the couple's request for alight and uncluttered space, creating simple and bespoke Shaker-style furniture made interesting with a beautiful mix of woods. "The walnut knobs accentuate the darker marks in the burr poplar veneer door panels, while the solid maple frames add contrast," explains Carlos. He goes on to point out that, "The square shape of the room with its two entry points including an extra-wide back door could have resulted in a very angular look to the furniture. So, we added the curved quadrants on the edges to soften the effect."

In need of ample space at mealtimes, Christine approached Foal Yard to make a maple dining table inlaid with black walnut to complement the kitchen cabinetry and enable at least six people to dine comfortably. "It's very useful when all the grandchildren are here," she says.

"He hasn't actually worked out how to get into it," she says of the pull-out arrangement, but that doesn't stop him trying!"

A dresser with sandblasted glass-fronted cabine offers lots of storage to keep worktops unclutter as Christine had wanted. "I hate grovelling about pans," she says, explaining that the corner draw are designed for ease of use. Appliances are kep out of sight, allowing the furniture's beauty to shir
